As at the 29th May, 1 resident is COVID positive and in isolation, feeling well and due to come out on Sunday. Sadly, Cornwallis had its first COVID-19 death within the home and our thoughts go out to their family at this time



1 further resident tested positive whilst in hospital and currently remains there.



The Care home is running on a full staffing compliment although there is some agency usage, this is regular agency staff

All staff are bearing up well under the pressure of the lockdown and appreciate all the gestures of support they are receiving and help from the RMBI Leadership Team.



There are currently 57 residents at Cornwallis Court which equates to an occupancy rate of 84%. There are presently 11 residential vacancies. If anyone would like more information on Cornwallis Court, please contact Denise on 01284 768028
